Session 1	June 18 th -21 st	1:00pm- 4:00pm	<p>“Ocean Life”- Students will create a ceramic sculpture and a painting on canvas focusing on the marvelous life of the ocean.</p> <p><i>* If coming from VBS students can come to the art building at 12:30 and have lunch while set up is going on.</i></p>	\$220 per person for 4 days
Session 2	June 24 th -28 th	8:30am- 11:30am	<p>“Amazing Landscapes”- Students will create a ceramic sculpture, a painting on canvas, and a water color drawing/painting exploring amazing landscapes from North Carolina to Rome, Ireland, or Africa.</p>	\$275 per person for 5 days
Session 3	June 24 th -28 th	12:00pm- 3:00pm	<p>“Around the world with Art”- Students will create a ceramic sculpture, a painting on canvas, and a water color drawing/painting emphasizing unique artworks from around the world Mexico to Russia, from China to Canada.</p>	\$275 per person for 5 days

Payment should be in the form of cash. Cash should be delivered in a sealed envelope brought to Ms. Brown. Payment and permission slip need to be turned in to designated a spot in the club. Space is limited to 23 students.

What to expect: Children should avoid wearing jewelry, and come to camp wearing safe rubber soled and closed toed shoes (no flip flops), long pants or shorts and comfortable tops that can get dirty.

Children should arrive on time each morning and be picked up promptly at the end of class by an approved parent or guardian.

Campers are responsible for showing up to camp prepared, arriving on time, and being respectful of other campers, instructors and all camp rules.

All registration is first come first serve and payment in full is due at the time of registration. All registration fees are non-refundable, as class size is limited.

Parents should notify me of any special needs, allergies, or medical conditions that they child may have. All parents will sign a release waiver outlining these and other important information about their child.
