



St. Ann School Boys Uniform Criteria

Pants

- Boys K- 6 wear navy blue pants which are designated for our school.
- Boys 7 -8 wear khaki pants.
- No cargo pants, jeans, studded, or corduroy pants allowed.
- Belt loops and black or brown belts required.

Shorts

- Boys K-6 may choose to wear navy blue shorts designated for our school year round except for December, January, and February.
- Boys 7- 8 wear khaki.
- Shorts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee and not fall below the knee

Belts

- Brown, blue, or black belt required if pants or shorts have belt loops (grades 1 – 8).
- Belts are not required for kindergarten students.

Shirts

- White oxford cloth dress shirt with pointed collar in long or short sleeve style or white knit shirt. Shirt tails should be tucked in.
- **T-shirts worn under shirts must be white with no printing or lettering.**

Turtleneck Shirts

- Plain white turtleneck shirts may be worn under uniform shirts, sweat shirts or sweaters.

Sweatshirts / sweaters

- A St. Ann sweatshirt or sweater vest may be worn as part of the uniform.
- Quarter-zips (gray for K – 6, navy for 7-8) and vests are available through Dennis Uniform.
- Previous years' crewneck sweatshirts with imprinted crest are also allowed.
- No other sweater or sweatshirt is allowed.

Shoes

- Tie or Velcro athletic shoe or hard soled shoe only.
- No flip flops, sandals, Crocs, moccasins, or boots allowed.

Socks

- White or navy crew socks may be worn. Socks must be visible.
