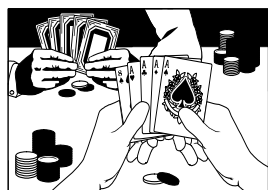


NURSERY STAFF POSITION - Ernie Valencia

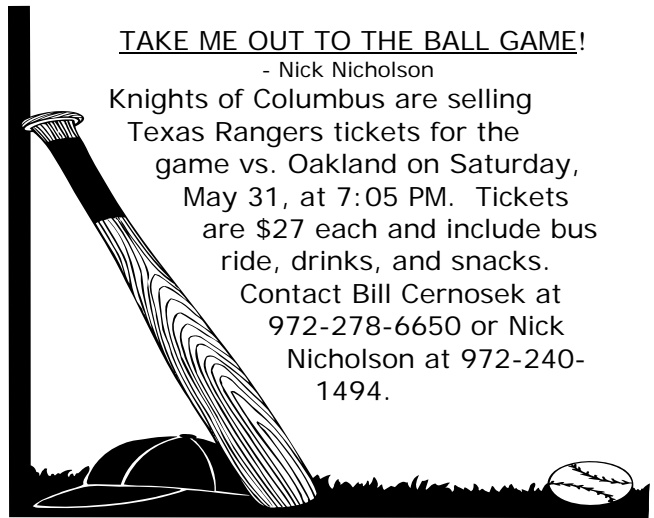

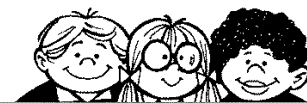

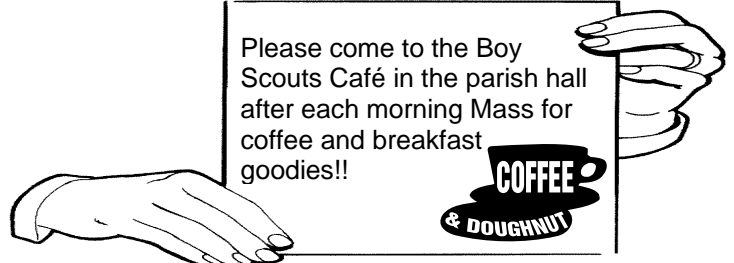


MASS INTENTIONS - Ernie Valencia
