"Jesus does not call the able, but he enables the called" (J. Alberione).

The call of Jesus includes all those who are marginalized, the tax collectors and the sinners. Jesus' call to conversion is also extended to those who are perceived to be "worthy" of a call, those who are ritually pure or who seem righteous and holy. His call to "follow me" implies a change in life to emulate his own way of living – with love and mercy. In calling us, God wants our love and mercy to become the new sacrifice of self for the good of others. To follow Jesus, then, means both to receive Jesus' mercy and to extend it to others.

He "came not to call the righteous but sinners". The call of Jesus does not depend on the merit of one's holiness or moral superiority. His call is not made on the basis of intellectual or academic brilliance nor on fitness for the job. Rather His call comes as a gratuitous gift of grace. He calls the poor, the outcast, sinners, and the marginalized. He then goes to their homes and eats and drinks with them. He asks His followers to be the finest instruments of love, joy and peace.

Following Him necessarily involves a breaking away from all that limits, controls and blocks us from going forth to attach ourselves to the values of Jesus. A disciple of Jesus does not cling to self-righteousness, merits or values but accepts Jesus' values and grows in holiness.
