



## **SETON CATHOLIC SCHOOLS Medication Guidelines and Permission Form**

- This form must accompany all medication brought to the school, complete with dosage and instructions for administering.
- Medications must be in original bottle.
- ALL medications (prescription or not-prescription) are to be taken directly to the office – never to lockers.
- Teachers and Staff are not permitted to give your child ANY medications unless you send them to school in the original bottle labeled with child's name, name of medicine, and dosage for that child. This includes Tylenol, Advil, Tums, Cough drops, cough medicine or any non-prescription+ medications.
- If your child has a cold and needs cough drops, you may send them to school and your student is to leave them in the office. They should be in the original container with the child's name on them. They can come to the office between classes if they need one.
