One Year Ago:

We had water that flowed uncontrolled from our roofs and parking lot, across sidewalks and courtyards, into drains that no longer functioned and had a row of trees along the southside that played a role in the demise of the drains. (Phase 1)



One Year Ago:

We completed studies that determined we had a serious water drainage problem, which had begun to undermine the foundations of most of the buildings on our campus.



One Year Ago:

We recognized the interior of our church was worn out, requiring restoration of pews, kneelers and flooring. (Phase 2)



One Year Ago:

We commenced the "Restore and Preserve" Capital Campaign.



In One Year:

The generosity of our Parishioners pledged \$1.2 million to Restore and Preserve St Patrick Church.



In One Year:

An astounding 75% of that pledge has been fulfilled.




In One Year:

Phase 1 of the campaign will be complete, the drainage system will have been repaired, our sidewalks and courtyards will be functioning properly, and new sacristy windows installed.



In One Year:

The choir loft has been renovated, eliminating safety issues and providing a user-friendly riser architecture, with new flooring and safety railings throughout.



In One Year:

The planning for Phase 2 is complete and bids have been solicited.

In One Year From Now:

Phase 2 will be completed and the Pews and kneelers will be refurbished, the flooring will be replaced with long term durable surfaces, and improvements to the choir loft sound system will be fully operational.

In One Year From Now:

We will assess our ability to address Phase 3, which involves structural modifications to improve accessibility to various areas of the church.

Parish Letter

Dear Members of our Parish Family,

You have generously pledged \$1,196,087 and donated \$863,659 to date toward our Capital Campaign's "Restore and Preserve" goal of \$1.2 million. These dedicated funds are sent to the Financial Office of the Diocese of Harrisburg each Monday morning where they are placed in the St. Patrick Church Capital Campaign Savings Account.

We want to assure you that ALL monies given for this Campaign will ONLY be used for this purpose. They are at our disposal on a daily basis and we do not need permission from the diocese to withdraw monies from this account, as we have already been granted permission last year from the diocese to go forward with this Campaign. These funds can only be withdrawn by our pastor, Fr. Carroll, to be used for the projects approved in Phase 1 of our Campaign. Our contract with Kinsley Construction for Phase 1 amounted to \$375,570 with \$33,396 in additional contract changes for a total of \$408,966, with the greater amount already approved by the Diocese.

Within the next several months, plans for Phase 2 will be addressed and shared with you. After we receive approval of the contract by the diocese, we can proceed with projects of this phase.

We also have a Phase 3 plan, but we will have to wait until after the contracts are signed for Phase 2 to ascertain the extent to which we can address Phase 3 projects.

Our parish is truly blessed by your generosity and our gratitude is beyond measure.
