### Notes to the Financial Report

- Immaculate Conception's report includes the parish school results
- Perpetual Help's report includes Mount Carmel Cemetery
- 2014 Donations at Immaculate Conception include a sizeable bequest from a parishioner
- 2015 Operations and Maintenance include the Immaculate Conception Renovations
- Program Expenses include subsidies from the parishes to the parish school
- Assessments include those assessments from the Archdiocese and Deanery, including detention ministry
- The rise in contracted services reflects additional services mandated by the Archdiocese of Seattle
- Immaculate Conception's 2015 deficit reflects the renovations to the church and a \$95,000 deficit at the parish school both paid for by the planned use a bequest received from 2013-2014
- Perpetual Help's deficit was covered from savings
