

## **Start-Up/3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Lesson Plan**

### **Session 20 - YEAR END REVIEW**

#### **Materials needed:**

- **Dry erase markers**
- Large candy bars for winning team (1 per student)
- Smaller candy bars for losing team (1 or 2 per student)
- Cards for “Heads Up” (in large tub)

#### **Prayer:**

#### **Our Father/Hail Mary/Glory Be**

#### **Say:**

- **I can't believe it's our last class! We've learned a lot this year but it can be easy to forget something we learned way back last October. Let's have a review of our year and play a game at the same time.**
- ( You can play a number of games with the following questions and terms.
- Divide the class into two teams and keep score as you go along. Play Tic-Tac-Toe, Pictionary or Taboo (kids can describe the term or answer to the question to their teammates but can't use the actual word. Ex. The keyword is Lent. One volunteer from the team can say things like “40 days before Easter” or “A time we give up something we like” but cannot actually use the word Lent.)
- Cards are also in your large tub if you'd like to play “Heads Up”. Divide kids into two teams. Sit at the front of the room and hold one of the cards up to your forehead so you cannot see it. Give the first team 4 tries to describe the term without using the actual word seeing if they can get you to guess the correct

answer. If they succeed, they get a point. If they fail, the word is discarded and it's the other team's turn.

Change up the games to keep it interesting.

If kids can't remember the answers, it's a good time for you to fill in so they have a review of the year. You might want to go back and review the lesson plans as you prepare 😊
