The First Characteristic of Discipleship at SEAS is to PRAY. Growing disciples have

a daily commitment to prayer. Prayer is simply talking and listening to God as

we would a close friend. It is both personal and communal.

In Week 2, Rolheiser raises the question of how do we hear the voice of God

when we are surrounded by so many voices in our world today? He answers his

own question by reminding us that Jesus leaves us the wonderful metaphor of

the "Good Shepherd." Using this metaphor Jesus tells us that just as sheep recognize the voice of their shepherd and follow him, so his followers recognize

his voice when they experience good in their lives. In other words, we find God

in what is good - since God, by definition, is good. - Fr. Mark

Fraudulent Emails

The archdiocese has received reports of fraudulent emails that appear to be coming from pastors. These emails have been occurring internationally over the past few years. Parishioners are being asked to send their pastor money or gift cards for various parish needs through a series of email messages. Official archdiocesan priest email addresses end in @dbqarch.org. These emails come from different addresses, often disguised to look like personal Gmail or Yahoo accounts. The body of these messages are generic and include phrases like: "Are you in the office now?," "How are you?," and "Please contact me." Please ignore such an email if you receive one.




Teen Lenten Small Group




40 Days For Life
