



Mini-Art Club Spring 2019

It is now time for students to consider joining the spring, **“Mini-Art Club”**. This is for “Elementary Students in 3rd and 4th grades, held on **Wednesdays beginning February 6th**. This is an after school club open to boys and girls who enjoy making challenging creative art projects. **Note: no class on Early Dismissal Days; 02//27, 03/27, 04/24 . On May 1st our last class, I will host our traditional “*Mini-Art Club Ice Cream Party/Bingo Game*”. Parents note on form below any food allergies - no nut products allowed. The total club fee for 10 classes is \$210.00. All payments are to Ronda Stieber (not StJPII). Students should come to the Art room at dismissal. Class ends at 5:00 p.m. Students will be walked down to Carpool for pick up or extended day as parents instruct. *If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may pick up your child from the art room.* * If a student misses a class due to illness they may see me to arrange to come for morning art to catch up.**

* *All Students are encouraged to bring water and snack.* Please pick up your child on time. Student’s whom have not been picked up by 5:15 p.m. may be charged according to the parent Handbook guidelines.

The planned “Mini-Art Club Projects” are:

1)Plaster Mache’ Animal – Students will use a pre-prepared foundation shape to build upon as they create a Plaster Mache’ Dog or Cat. We will paint the finished project with acrylic paints then add wiggly eyes, pom-pom for the nose and add multi media to decorate details. About 7”.

2) Aluminum Metal Molding-36 gauge- Students will use a template to draw on their metal a Cross Design with choices for the end shape then use molding tools to form 2/D shapes then a variety of etching tools will be used to emboss designs on to the metal to decorate as they like. Their 11” Cross will be mounted on Mat Board.

3) Hanging Canvas- A wood frame secures the top/bottom with a hanger- Students will select from a huge variety of templates to draw and decorate the canvas with permanent Sharpies in every color as well as use their own ideas while using their own first name as part of the focus. 8” X 10 “.
