You'll notice that our Sunday bulletin has a new look this week. Our contract with the company that was publishing our bulletin expired at the end of June and, after consulting with the parish council, I decided to use that company's services only for a monthly four-page bulletin, with simpler weekly two-page updates that we will print in our parish office. Since much of the material in each week's bulletin was repeated, this will save paper, time, and energy. And, perhaps most importantly, it will give us some much-needed flexibility with respect to printing dates. But please know that the two-page weekly update will still provide you with all of the essential information that our weekly bulletins did (based on the results of last year's survey asking which parts of the bulletin you most frequently consult or read). The monthly four-page bulletin will contain items that don't change as frequently (like all of the information that appeared regularly on the front and back pages of the bulletin) as well as other less time-sensitive features.

Around the Parish...

Totus Tuus - Please welcome to our parish the team of young adults who will be directing this week's Totus Tuus program for students entering grades 1-12. We are proud that two of the team members grew up here at St. Ann's - Collin Backus and Mallory Shehan. The other team members are Regina Phillips, a graduate of Holy Cross Catholic Academy and WTAMU, and Joshua Heinen, a Texas Tech student from Plainview. Please keep them in your prayers throughout the week ahead. Please also pray for the young people of our parish this week as they participate in this five-day program of evangelization and catechesis!

The program for students entering grades 1-5 begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday. Students should bring a sack lunch each day (except for Friday, when we will have a pizza party). On Friday, students should wear clothes that they can get wet. Please be prompt in dropping off and picking up students each day.

The program for students entering grades 6-12 begins at 7:00 p.m. (except on Wednesday, when we will begin with Mass at 6:00 p.m. in the church, followed by our weekly meal at 6:30 p.m.) and ends at 9:00 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday.

Parish Picnic/Pool Party - Our annual summer parish picnic and pool party is scheduled for the evening of Sunday, July 29. Food will be served from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. and the Canyon Aqua Park will be open from 8:00 to 10:00 p.m. Please make plans to join us!
