GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

Why I Am a Knight



I come from a Catholic family and attended twelve years of Catholic education in the cathedral of our Pennsylvania home. Once I entered college however I fell away from the routine of attending Mass except for holidays. That's not atypical for a young person. I don't know what drove me but once I moved to the DC region in the early 1990s I started sporadically back to Mass. I'm sure a part of it was wanting familiarity in a new environment and part of it was God trying to keep me on track (He tried, but wasn't always successful!) That Fisherman's hook however was still embedded in me. I thank my parents and St. Peter Cathedral school and Cathedral Prep high school for somehow getting just enough knowledge and Faith

through my thick skull.

I don't consider myself a worthy Catholic. I continue to fall from grace more times than I deserve to recover from. I have to believe Jesus was on earth looking not for the perfect person but for the sinner.

When I see people wearing their faith on their sleeve I realize that I'll never be one of them. I'm built not to man the barricade but to aid people in everyday situations.

This is all a way of saying I see the Knights of Columbus as a calling to aid people in need of a helping hand. We don't just parade around we get our hands dirty. Knights don't care if the people in danger are Catholic or atheist, we help all. I saw a story of a woman who wanted to travel to an area to help after a natural disaster struck. She told a friend that she doesn't know how she can help once she gets there. The person simply replied, and I'm paraphrasing, "don't worry the Knights of Columbus will already be there, just find them". That is why I'm a knight, we get things done where it's needed. We don't fight silly ideological battles ranting away on blogs or shouting over people, we simply get the job done.

As far as membership in our Order we don't judge the level of your Faith, if we did I would never have been accepted into the Knights. If you find us in good faith we will put you to work one way or another.

As a Catholic and as a member of the Order I believe:

- . We must serve God, our family and our country.
- . We must aid those in need.
- . We must get dirty, none of this hiding in ivory towers for us.
- . We must make mistakes, brush ourselves off and start again.
- . We must not judge others (that is for God), we forgive and show mercy to those who make mistakes.

- . We must remember our actions are a reflection on our families and our Church.
- . We must be proud, but not prideful, to be Catholic and Knights.

These are the reasons I'm a Knight and a member of this special council.

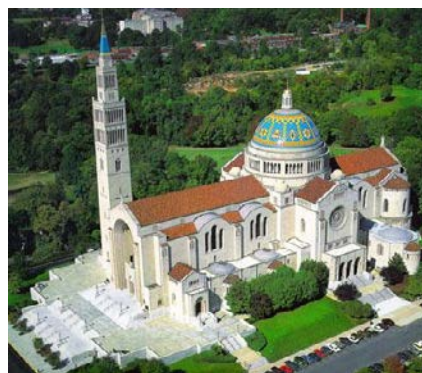

We have the county's only Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration here at St. Agnes. However this is a bigger responsibility that needs the support of all diocesan parishioners. We need assistance in maintaining the 24 hour vigil. This adoration is extremely important for us to keep it going.

If you, your wife or someone else you know may be interested in this unique ministry please contact me, Dan Sullivan. I can answer any questions you have on the program and help you arrange the best time to spend in silent prayer with the Eucharist.

There is a real need for gentlemen to volunteer overnight. Fully half of the adorers from 10 pm until 6 am are women, and, although we have keypad locks on the doors, many of these women have expressed unease at being alone in the chapel over night. (Typically, we have only one adorer for any given hour; during the day, there are usually quite a few adorers in the chapel, but not so at night.)

My thought is that asking Knights to adore Christ in the Eucharist during the hours covered by women would serve not only the spiritual purposes to which Knights are committed but the "knightly" function that our moniker implies.

You can commit to a permanent time slot or sign up to be a substitute as needed.
