**Meditations on Holy Mass
Easter Day (C)
21 April 2019**

First reading: Acts 10.34a, 37-43 CCC 438, 453, 486, 1289; 995
We ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

Second reading: Colossians 3.1-4 CCC 1002, 1003, 1420
Seek the things that are above, where Christ is.

Gospel: John 20.1-18++ CCC 640, 640*, 443, 660

According to the Scripture: Jesus must rise from the dead.

In the *first reading* St. Luke records the testimony of St. Peter, who had seen with his own eyes the Risen Lord. Peter had spoken with him and had eaten with him. Our Faith is based on actual events, not stories. In his *Gospel*, St. John reports his own witness to the Resurrection at the moment when he first believed. John himself saw the undisturbed linen wrappings where Jesus had lain, but through which the Risen Lord had passed, without moving the cloth. Jesus rose from the dead in a glorified body, one that now can pass through material objects. Yet he ate and drank with his disciples after the Resurrection. In the *second reading*, St. Paul explains that discipleship with Christ means death to sin and a union of hearts and minds with Jesus.

Before Mass: Very early on the Sunday morning, just after the sun had risen, they came to the tomb, alleluia (*Lauds*)

After Mass: On the evening of that Sunday, when the disciples were gathered behind locked doors, Jesus came and stood among them. He said to them, "Peace be with you." Alleluia. (*Vespers*)

Message from the Rector

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Christ is risen, ALLELUIA! On behalf of Father Steve, the parish clergy and staff, I wish all parishioners – and those who will be visiting and praying with us this Easter weekend – blessed and joyous celebrations of the Lord's Resurrection. Saint Augustine said that the Easter Vigil, the night when Jesus Christ was raised from the dead, is to be considered the "mother of all vigils." During this night, the people of God keep watch as we await the resurrection of the Lord and celebrate the sacraments of initiation. We have the grace of two adults who will be baptized this year, and several others who will be completing their sacraments of initiation and coming into full communion with our Catholic Church. The seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost are celebrated as one great feast day. Saint Athanasius called them "the great Sunday." We sing the "Alleluia" during these days in rejoicing. Each day of Easter Week is celebrated as a solemnity as we continue our Easter Sunday celebration until the Second Sunday of Easter, which has now acquired the additional name of "Divine Mercy Sunday". At the 12:15 PM Mass on April 28, two of our young parishioners – Joseph and Raphael – will be confirmed by Auxiliary Bishop Christian Riesbeck. Please keep them in your prayers as they begin their adult journey of faith, calling them to be courageous witnesses of our Faith as they grow in holiness responding to the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Throughout the Easter Season, we will continue using the Apostles' Creed, which is the baptismal creed of the Church of Rome.
