Meditations on Holy Mass

Pentecost (Year C)

First reading: Acts 2.1-11 CCC 696
All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages.

Second reading: 1 Corinthians 12.3b-7,12-13
In the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body.

Gospel: John 20.19-23
As the Father has sent me, so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit -OR- Optional readings for Year C

Second reading: Romans 8.8-17 CCC 695
For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons and daughters of God.

Gospel: John 14.15-16, 23b-26 CCC 692
The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything.

In the *first reading*, from Romans, St. Paul teaches that the gift of the Holy Spirit is linked to the universal call to holiness and to salvation in Christ. This complements *the Gospel*, in which St. John recalls the Lord's reply to Judas, namely that anyone who accepts the Gospel and keeps the commandments will be saved. It is the Holy Spirit who enables us to leave a full Christian life. In the *second reading*, St. Paul repeats the promise that our decision to live in the Spirit brings life to all who do so.

Before Mass: *Receive the Holy Spirit; the sins of those you forgive shall be forgiven, alleluia. (Lauds)*

After Mass: *Today we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, alleluia; on this day the Holy Spirit appeared before the apostles in tongues of fire and gave them his spiritual gifts. He sent them out to preach to the whole world, and to proclaim that all who believe and are baptized shall be saved, alleluia. (Vespers)*

Message from the Rector

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Evening Prayer of Sunday of this Pentecost Day completes the Season of Easter. The Easter (Paschal) Candle will be placed near our baptismal font and will be lit at the moment of baptisms and funerals, the former reminding us that we are buried in the death of Christ in order to rise with him in the newness of faith, and the latter time as a reminder of our faith in the resurrection of the body made possible by our faith in our Risen Lord Jesus Christ. A double Alleluia is added to the dismissal today, an echo of our Easter celebrations.

On Monday, we return to Ordinary Time (Tenth Week). In his Apostolic Letter approving the Roman Calendar in 1969, St. Paul VI noted some important facts about the Liturgical Year: over many centuries, Catholics had become accustomed to many special devotions such that the mysteries of redemption lost their proper place (large number of vigils, holy days and octaves – the growing dominance of various seasons over the Church year). Saint Pius X and St. John XXIII restored Sunday to its former dignity, so that everyone should once more consider it as the Church's original Feast Day. The celebration of the Liturgical Year has a special sacramental power and force which nourishes and strengthens the life of Christians. It is not merely a recalling of historical events. During Ordinary Time, we are invited to share more fully in the entire mystery of Christ as it unfolds throughout the year. (Ordo, page 252)

We welcome to our assisting clergy Fr. Prajak Boonphao. Fr. Prajak, a priest of the Diocese of Bangkok (Thailand), is completing the last year of his doctoral program in Canon Law at St. Paul University. We are grateful for his ministry, which he will principally exercise at daily Masses and Confessions.
