ST. JUDE PARISH ART SHOW
*******PLEASE READ*******

We are so excited to again be hosting a community art show at St. Jude. This year the show will be in conjunction with the International Food Festival on October 21st. We welcome original art submissions from the community. Please share your artistic talents with us.

The show will be *juried* meaning that not every piece will be displayed AND we will have ribbons and medals awarded to the judge's favorites in 4 divisions:

- 1) Adult
- 2) children in grades K-2
- 3) children in grades 3 - 6
- 4) children in grades 7 - 12.

(Special needs individuals should enter at their appropriate developmental level and indicate this on the paperwork.)

To make the show successful, we have some guidelines which must be followed:

What will be accepted:

Any original 2D hand-generated media will be accepted including:

drawing, painting, mixed media, collage, printmaking, and scratchboard.

Sculptures are acceptable only if they meet all other criteria AND are wired and can safely hang on a flat wall like a 2D art piece.

Up to TWO entries per artist are allowed. At this time, we are not accepting photography but are considering it for coming years.

Content must not be controversial and must be family friendly. We reserve the right to reject any piece deemed not appropriate.

Important information for drop off and pick up of art:

All submissions must be dropped off in person to the main office of St Jude on 10/15/2018_during normal business hours to the attention of **Ann Mikelonis**. All artwork must be picked up after the show either on 10/21/18 between 4:30 – 5:30pm OR on Monday 10/22/18 in the main office of the church during business hours.

Conditions of participation:

Any member of the community is eligible. You do not have to belong to St. Jude Church.

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All entries must be matted and/or framed and ready-to-hang with secure wiring that does not stretch above the art when hanging. Gallery-wrapped canvas is acceptable provided that the edges are finished. **Sawtooth hangers or picture rings without a wire are not acceptable.** If your work is not framed, we will consider it for inclusion in the show as long as it is neatly presented, has a secure wire on the back for hanging AND the artist understands that we cannot guarantee that the artwork will not be damaged during the storage/judging period before the show.

Entries must not weigh more than 20 lbs including the frame and no glass is allowed (acrylic or plexiglass is acceptable). Again, we are not responsible for any breakage or damage for any reason so consider this when deciding to enter. Maximum size of the allowed entry, including frame, is 30" in any one direction.

Artist must submit the signed **ARTIST Release of Liability** and an ID tag for each piece of art along with the artwork. These forms are found on the St. Jude website. No art will be accepted without the completed paperwork.

Show dates and times:

Selected art as determined by the Juror will be on display in the Parish Hall during the International Food Festival on 10/21/18 from 1:00- 4:30. Prizes will be awarded during the International Fair and Art Show between 4:00 – 4:30 on Sunday 10/21/18.
