# MISSION WEEK 2019

JUNE 10-13

**Open to incoming 7th-12th grade students (2019-2020 school year) AND 2019 seniors!**

Interested middle and high school students are invited to share their gifts with those in need while participating in **MISSION WEEK 2019!** This is an annual week of service, in and around our local community, that allows the Catholic youth to extend their hand, share their gifts, and have a little fun while doing giving back to the community. **Are you willing to brave the heat...get off the couch...and serve?!**

## Mission Week 2019:

Our week begins on Sunday, June 9 with Mass and a kick-off celebration. Families are encouraged to attend the 5:00pm Mass at St. Jude, followed by meeting in the Parish Hall for pizza, ice cream, fellowship, t-shirt pick up, and a parent info session. This will be a great time for teens to get to know each other and meet those they'll be working with all week!

Monday thru Thursday of this week, participants will gather in the Reception Area by the gray couches at **8:15am**. We will start each day with Mass. After this morning prayer time, youth will be fed breakfast, experience a time of praise and worship, and gather in their work crews for daily instructions and work assignments. Participants will be exposed to a variety of service opportunities throughout the week.

Participants will be fed lunch each day. Lunch time will serve as an opportunity for faith discussion and prayer together. Time will be spent each day directed toward "service learning" activities based on our Catholic Social Teaching.

The cost for youth participants is **\$50** (*checks made payable to St. Jude with "mission week" on memo line*). The youth fee covers breakfast and lunch each day, work supplies, and a t-shirt. Additional donations are graciously accepted and will be used for scholarships and supplies.
