Scott Holland – 1984 - 2006
&
Jakob Hwang – 2000 - 2018**

The cast wishes to offer tonight's prayer in memory of two of our alumni, Scott Holland '02 and Jakob Hwang '18.

Scott played the role of Jesus for several years in the Living Station. He will be remembered for how he lived life to the fullest, pursued his passions, and for the fun-loving personality and smile he always seemed to have. From the time he was young, he dreamed of becoming a pilot. After graduating from Bowling Green State University in 2006, his dream came true and he became a pilot for Air American Advertising and flew aerial banners over sports stadiums. While flying to the 2006 MLB All-Star Game in Pittsburgh, he encountered mechanical problems and attempted an emergency landing. Unfortunately, he did not survive.

Jakob was a member of the Class of 2018 who lost his life to cancer shortly after graduation. While at EC, Jakob was a "legendary" goalie for the boys soccer team and very active in faith based activities on campus. He was most known for his infectious smile, positive attitude and complete trust and faith in God's plan. Those who met or knew Jakob was touched by his presence. He made quite an impact on our community.

The Living Stations of the Cross cast contributes a portion of its proceeds to "The Scott Holland Memorial Scholarship", and the "Jakob Hwang Memorial Scholarship" which is awarded to an Elyria Catholic junior each year to assist with their tuition.
