READINGS (cf. *Ceremonial Guidelines* 8.1 & 8.3)

The Lectionary (763-767) offers several options for Confirmation Masses, which may be used on any day except on Sundays and Solemnities when the readings of the day must be used.

N.B.: Following the ancient tradition of the Church, during the Paschal Season the First Reading is taken from the Acts of the Apostles. The Second Reading can be taken from one of the Letters of the New Testament. It is not appropriate to have an Old Testament Reading during the Easter Season. Except for the Paschal Season, it is not appropriate to have both readings taken from the New Testament. It is never appropriate to have both readings taken from the Old Testament.
