- Manage homeroom responsibilities and administrative duties for a classroom
- Responsible for lesson planning, instruction, and assessment
- Supervise students throughout the school day
- Integrate and conduct small group and individual student instruction during the school day
- Other tasks assigned by school leadership

Individuals applying for a position must be able to support and promote the Catholic identity of the school. The person must be experienced at planning and implementing curriculum, be skillful at appropriately integrating technology into lessons, and have an understanding of differentiated classrooms.

A valid California Teaching credential* (or a reciprocal credential from another state)

Classroom management skills

Teaching experience with children

Demonstrated communication skills with parents, faculty, and students

Ability to utilize technology in a classroom environment and to integrate technology on a daily basis

Commitment to excellence and rigor

* If the candidate does not yet possess a valid California teaching credential, (s)he must acquire one within five years of the date of hire
