### **Position: Full-time Math Teacher**

Archbishop Riordan High School is hiring a full-time teacher in the math department. The position could include sections of the following classes: Algebra, Geometry and Math Analysis/Pre-Calc.

There is also an option for this role to teach four sections, while holding the department chair position.
