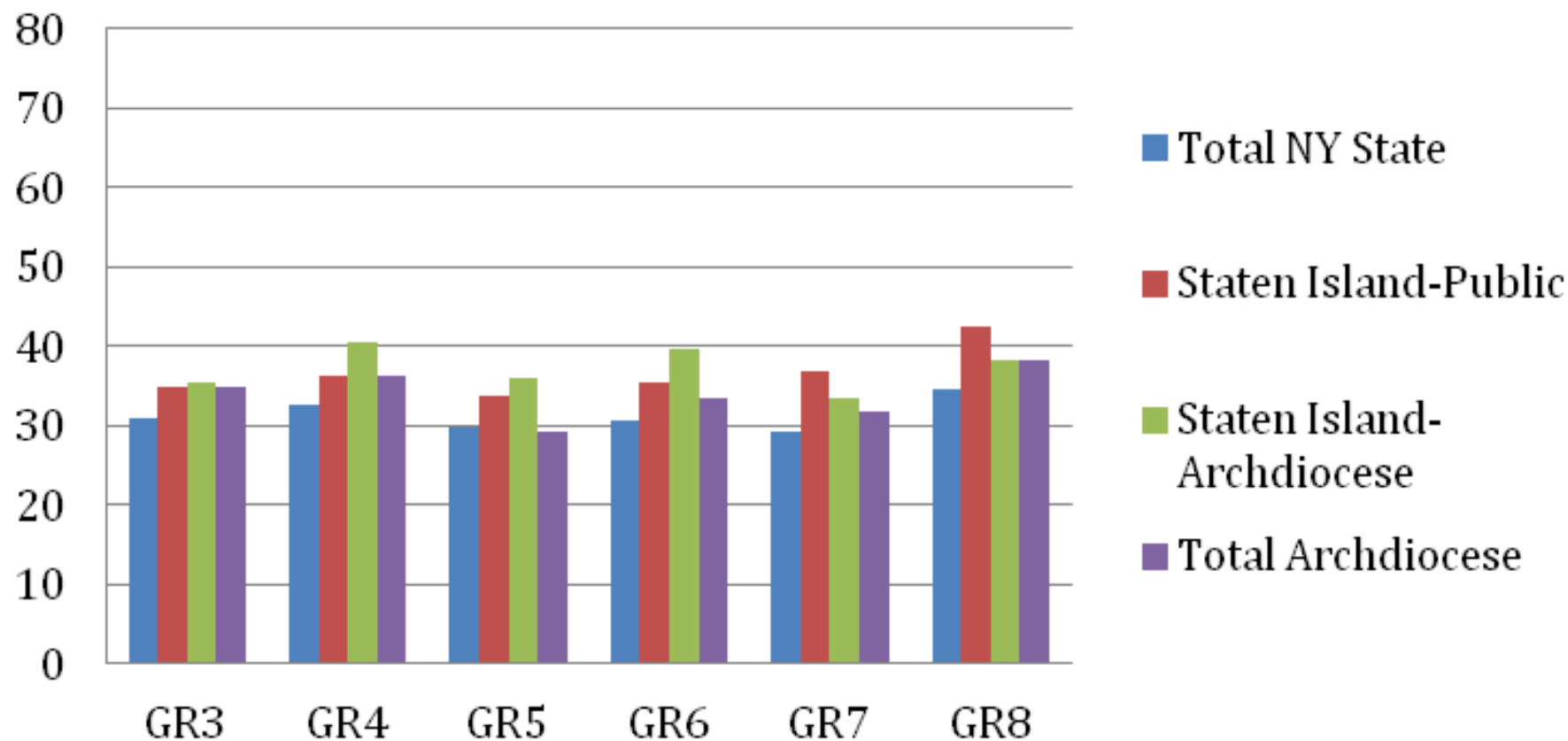

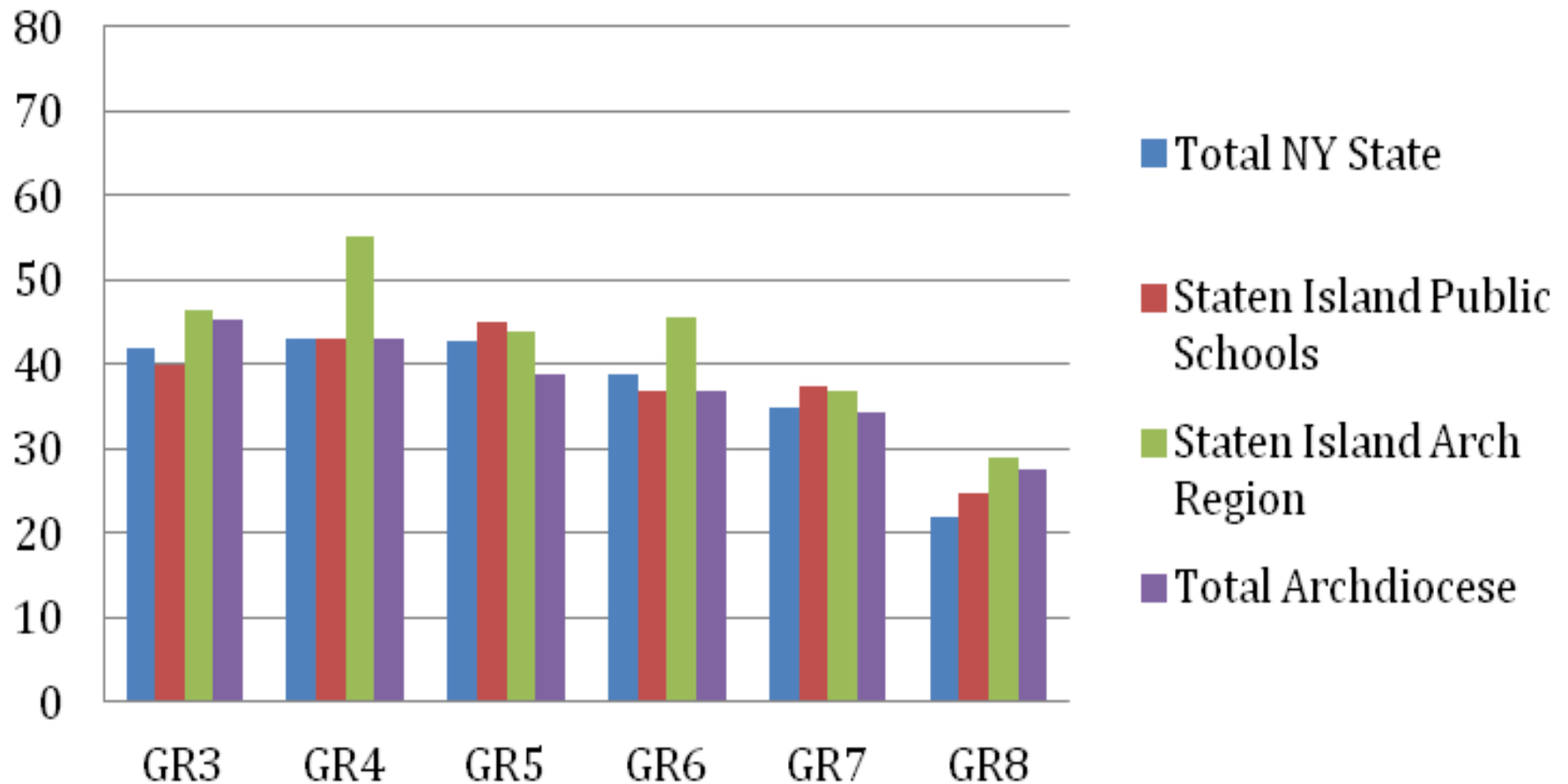
# STATEN ISLAND REGION ELA
