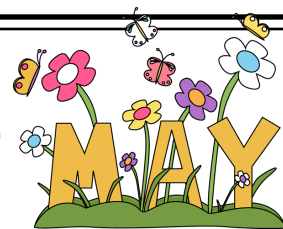

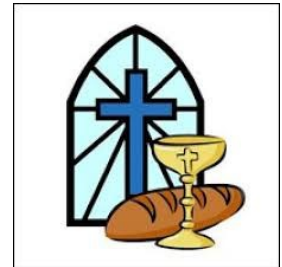

Quick Facts About Planned Parenthood
