## Grand Knight's Report

“God - Family - Country”



### “A New Council at Resurrection?”

Rumors; they seem to fascinate us and undoubtedly, they always get our attention. The difficult part is getting to the truth. Rumors are counterproductive and do a lot of damage. Since the number of phone calls to our Financial Secretary and I have become overwhelming, let's put some of those to rest.

At this point, I can say that there is a **rumored** proposal to start up a new Knights of Columbus Council at Resurrection. I do not know who this request is actually coming from **since I have not been formally notified by the resident Pastor (currently out of the country)**, nor our **District Deputy**. In fact, speaking to the District Deputy (July 25, 2018 meeting), he has not been notified by the Pastor either. As soon as I hear it officially, I will let you know.

A new council at Resurrection is not an official Knights of Columbus initiative at this point. Your council's Grand Knight, me, would normally be notified of the request to start a new council by the Round-Table coordinator or the District Deputy, when requested by the Pastor. The Resurrection Round-Table coordinator is Ralph Mosley and he has not notified me of any request and neither has the District Deputy. Whether I agree, or not, is not relevant, so please do not put words in my mouth. The decision to form a new council is a **Pastoral decision** and if confirmed, **it will be respected and honored: no exceptions.**

If this rumor is true, then what does a “new” council at Resurrection mean to us at Council 4727. Well, from everything I have read from Supreme, and their New Council Development Guidelines, the following directly pertains to us:

- \* First of all, our Council is not “splitting.” A new Council is being created.
- \* **We would remain** as Council 4727 supporting Christ the King parish.
- \* **We would retain** all of our members regardless of what church they attend **unless they personally “request” a formal transfer.** Per Supremes' guidelines “*in order to form a new council, 30 new members for the new council must be recruited. This includes new members, former members, and transfers, although transfers should be held to a minimum.*”
- \* **No one should be trying to force you to transfer**, it is a **personal** choice and when the time comes, you can either stay or request a transfer.
- \* If you do decide to transfer to a new council, your dues at the new council will be adjusted to reflect what you have paid at our council (pro-rated). **We will assist you in making sure the transition is as painless as possible.**
- \* At this point, any requests for you to transfer are inappropriate and in poor taste, since the District Deputy **has not started** a “new council process.”
- \* **We will retain all of our financial and physical assets.** Again, we are not splitting our council. Our written agreement with the ACA remains in effect until 2036 unless our council is suspended, dissolved or otherwise no longer exists - which is not occurring.
- \* **All council activities/finances in support of Resurrection Catholic Church** would become the responsibility of the new Council and would be removed from our budget and calendar of events.
- \* **Keep in mind that we will continue to support Resurrection** until such time a new council at Resurrection is formed or I get notification from the Pastor or District Deputy to officially stop our support.

Until the District Deputy acts on a **formal request from the Pastor**, assesses the feasibility of the request, and new council steps are officially begun, there is no action required of anyone in our council.

**Let me make this perfectly clear: if anyone from our council harasses you about transferring notify me immediately.** That type of action will not be tolerated nor will we tolerate anyone trying to force you to move.

I ask that you **pray** for our council, that our **families** and **friendships** are not disrupted by the formation of the new council, should it occur. We are Knights. I expect all of us to be civil and remember we will support our Church, or Families and our Country.
