**Archdiocese of Santa Fe Cooperates with
Law Enforcement Investigation Regarding
Marvin Archuleta and Sabine Griego**

ALBUQUERQUE – Wednesday, November 28, 2018– IMMEDIATE RELEASE – Today, the Archdiocese of Santa Fe provided documents to agents with the New Mexico Office of the Attorney General regarding two priests who have been credibly accused of committing child sexual abuse: Marvin Archuleta and Sabine Griego. Both men are listed on the Archdiocese of Santa Fe’s List of Priests, Deacons, Religious and Seminarians Accused of Sexual Abuse of Children, which was first published in September 2017.

Pursuant to a criminal investigation into the activities of these two men, the Office of the Attorney General obtained a search warrant for documents relating to their service in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. The archdiocese’s staff has worked cooperatively with the Attorney General’s agents, who have been courteous and professional throughout this process, to provide the requested documents. The archdiocese continues in its commitment to cooperate with and assist law enforcement in the pursuit of justice for all victims of the terrible crime of clergy child sexual abuse. We look forward to continued cooperation with the Attorney General and other law enforcement agencies in these efforts, while ensuring compliance with existing court orders to ensure the privacy of victims and innocent parties is protected.
