Shrove Tuesday: The day before Lent begins on Ash Wednesday was a customary time to seek pardon in the Sacrament of Confession in preparation for the holy season of Lent. **Lent** is a time of abstinence, of giving things up. So historically, Shrove Tuesday was the last chance to indulge yourself, and to use up the foods that weren't allowed in Lent. Pancakes are eaten on this day because they contain fat, butter and eggs which were forbidden during Lent. Also celebrated as Mardi Gras and Fat Tuesday.
