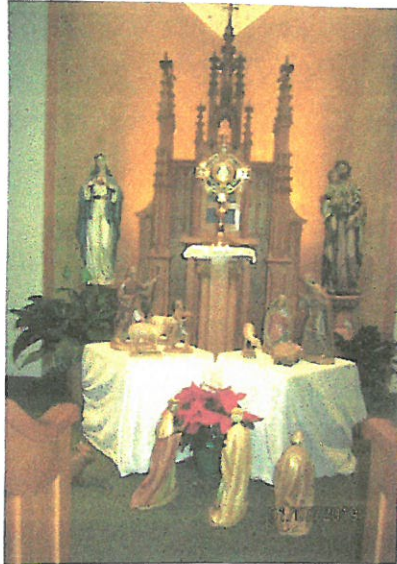

PRAY FOR THE SPREAD OF PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Copies of the prayer on the front page were sent to our parish by a group in New York who is promoting the spread of Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration across the nation. There is a copy of this prayer in the Prayer Intention books located in the pews. From time to time, copies will be in the rack near the sign in book.

In addition to the above promotion, two Catholics from Poland have begun an initiative to establish Centers of Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration for Peace on every continent for the intention of world peace across the globe. So far, they have established 8 centers of adoration: in Bethlehem, Kazakhstan, the Philippines, South Korea, Kibeho Rwanda, Ivory Coast, Medjugorje, and Niepokalanow Poland. They plan 2 centers in the Americas and two in Oceania. They feel that the adoration prayers in South Korea are helping to soften the relations between North and South Korea. Their work is written up in the December 23 - January 5 edition of the National Catholic Register.

At SEAS we know the value of Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration. Let us pray for the spread of this devotion.

2. In the BACK OF THE SIGN IN BOOK, there is a chart that shows the pray-ers who are scheduled for each hour. Behind that chart is another section which has the telephone numbers of the pray-ers.
