Read the Gospel for today Luke 11:29-32

### **REFLECTION:**

In our increasingly visual culture with iPhones and Instagram it seems normal to ask for some proof if someone is making a big claim. We need a “sign” if we are supposed to truly believe what we are hearing. In our prayer and when we struggle with doubt, we can be tempted to ask God for a sign to let us know that He is truly there.

But this mindset can lead to a big problem. Sometimes we can be so focused on a big “sign” from God to answer our prayers that we can become oblivious to the way Christ is working in our lives on a day-to-day basis. In this passage, the people were looking for Jesus to provide “proof” through a big miracle or sign, but we know that Jesus’ coming to earth, dying on the cross, and being resurrected is the “sign” that brings us eternal life.

### **CHALLENGE**

This week, ask God to help you see small blessings in your own life that teach you more about Him and His love for you.
