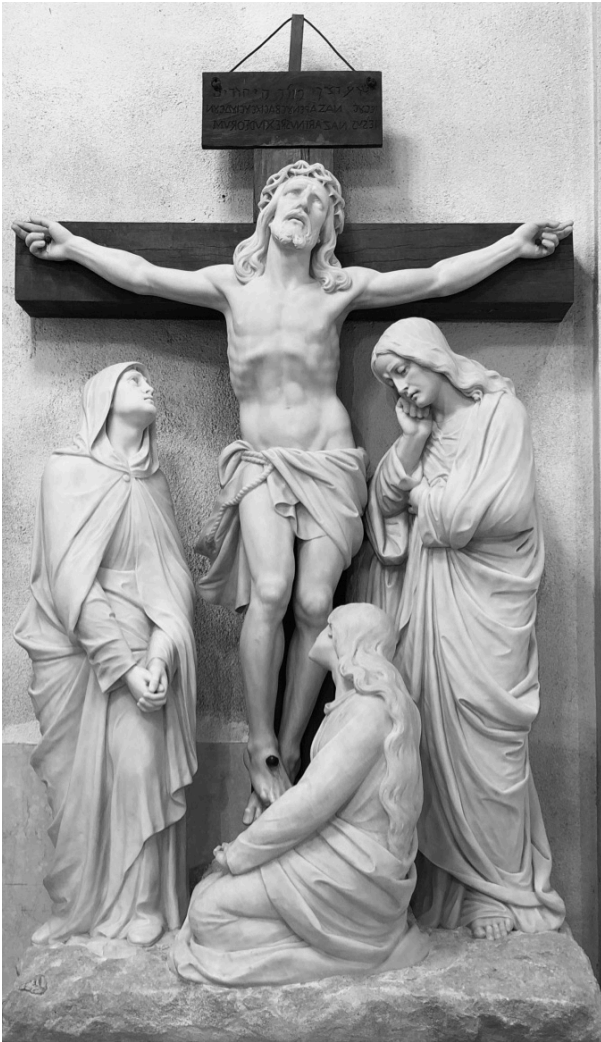

*Rev. William Scott Daniels, O.P. is a member of the Southern Dominican Province of St. Martin de Porres currently serving as parochial vicar at St. Dominic’s parish in Lakeview and the Provincial Promoter of the Holy Name Society. Fr. Scott was ordained on May 21, 2005 and has served as chaplain and teacher at St. Agnes Academy-St. Dominic School and St. Benedict at Auburndale both in Memphis. In 2009, Fr. Scott began working with Fr. Frank Pavone at Priests for Life as a Priest Associate traveling the country giving parish missions and speaking at Pro Life events. In 2013, Fr. Scott began working in parish ministry on Long Island. He returned to work and to live in the Province in July, 2018 where he currently ministers at St. Dominic Parish in Lakeview. Fr. Scott is also chaplain for the Legion of Mary, Our Lady of the Cenacle Praesidium at Our Lady of the Rosary Parish in New Orleans.*
