Clynk for Schools Recycling Challenge

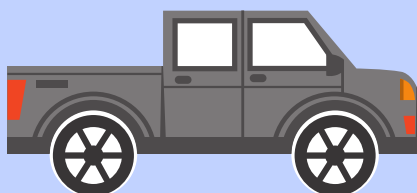
Last chance to turn your bottles and cans in to support the school during this challenge! It ends tomorrow, March 22nd!
