Minutes of Meeting – 03/14/2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:12 p.m. by Sue Pakiz. Father Leo opened with a prayer.

Positive feedback has been giving regarding The Stations Of The Cross. Mission money can be used to help college and/or CCD students who would like to attend mission trips or educational trips. A person just needs to ask about these funds. The baby bottle fundraiser is now in progress. There are no other fundraisers going at this time.**
- VI. Father Leo updated everyone about the communication between the three parishes. Discussion was had by all. The pastoral councils need to get a calendar to the office showing parish dates for year, 2020. This information should be given to Margie by April 11. Starting December, there will be a calendar for all three parishes.**
