MISSION TRIP DETAILS

Place we'll be staying: Central Catholic High School, 320 West View Ave., Steubenville, OH

Where we'll leave from and return to: Our Lady of Lourdes

Day and time we'll leave: 1:00pm on Sunday, July 14

Day and time we'll return: approximately 11:00am on Friday, July 19

Typical schedule during the week:

6:15am - wake up

6:45 - breakfast

7:30 - morning program

8:30 - leave for worksite

3:00 - return from worksite

3:15 - free time

5:15 - dinner

7:00 - evening program (skits, praise and worship music, talks, etc.),
followed by free time

10:30 - return to sleeping quarters

11:00 - lights out

What to do to attend the Mission Trip:

1. Commit ASAP, by contacting Fr. Zach at 724-947-3363 or lolol@verizon.net. Space is limited!
2. Bring the cost down by helping with one fundraiser. You would arrive in the church hall at 9am on a Saturday morning, and assemble hoagies for a few hours. It would also be appreciated if you could help sell the hoagies after one or two Masses those weekends.
3. Complete all the necessary paperwork that Fr. Zach will provide at a later date. This would include: an application form, a medical form, and a code of conduct form.
4. Make deposits of \$50 by March 1st and April 1st, and pay the remaining \$90 by May 1st. If we do well with our fundraiser, you will be partially reimbursed.
5. Any teens who will have turned 18 years old before July 19 will need to go through the Diocese of Pittsburgh's safe environment training and clearances. Fr. Zach will coordinate this. You would just need to fill out the form on the diocesan website, and attend the training session whenever it gets scheduled.
