

Dear Parents,

We are excited to announce that on Wednesday, May 15, 2019, the Pre-K and Kindergarten children will be going on a class trip. We will be going to Johnson's Corner Farm located in Medford, NJ. This trip was developed to teach children how plants grow, how to care for them and how to appreciate farming. Each child will take home their own garden to watch grow. It also includes a hayride to see what is going on at the farm in the spring and the children will visit the Animal Farm to feed the animals and play in the Discovery Barnyard.

The children are to wear their SKS uniform and sneakers. Please listen to the weather and dress them appropriately. Please pack your child a brown bag lunch, including a beverage, labeled with their name. Everything needs to be disposable. No water bottles or plastic containers that need to come home.

We will leave SKS, by school bus, at 9:00am and leave the farm at 1:00pm. The cost of the trip is \$25.00 for children and \$14.00 for chaperones. Please wait to hear from your child's teacher before sending money for chaperones. Space is limited and all chaperones must have clearances on file in the rectory. We need to receive confirmation from the rectory for all chaperones before accepting your payment. All checks are to be made payable to SKS.

Please return the Permission Form (print it from the website), payment for your child, and the chaperone form on or before Thursday, April 4, 2019. This will allow enough time to receive confirmation from the rectory for chaperones and inform you in a timely manner.
