Since the topic of sexuality and other issues are often difficult for parents to discuss with their children and teens, and because parents often do not know what the Church teaches with regard to these matters, the Parent Night is required. There parents will discover the truth and beauty of the Church's teachings, will preview the content of the presentations, and will be given practical tools and suggestions to fulfill their responsibilities during this critical time in the life of their children.
