TOURNAMENT RULES

- **NO** coolers or alcoholic beverages are allowed on the golf course.
- The proceeds will benefit the Saint Anna Catholic School.
- Your donation may qualify for a matching gift from your company. This is extra step can help us in our fundraising goal.
- Please turn in your official tournament scorecards to the **clubhouse**. **ONLY** official scorecards will be accepted. Please sign, date and attest all cards. *No scorecards will be accepted after 7pm.*
- The tournament will be played in scramble format. **NO** minimum requirement of tee shots must be used from each player in a group.
- Maximum score per hole is a double bogie.
- Mulligans: Limit of 4 per team. **EACH PLAYER** can only use one mulligan. Mulligans cannot be used for Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin, Skins, or Las Vegas Hole.
- Men hit from the **WHITE MARKERS**. Women and kids hit from the **RED MARKERS**.
- Play **FAST** and keep pace with the group in front of you.
- **Preferred lies** will be played **EVERYWHERE**. The only exceptions will be out-of-bounds and hazard areas. When choosing a lie, you may use **up to one club length's distance (no nearer to the hole and balls in rough must stay in the rough!)**. Please mark your group's designated shot with a tee before hitting each set of shot. You may hit in any order, at any shot.
- **DO NOT** putt out before all members of your group have putted! This counts as your score for the hole. The best way to protect against this is to mark all putts.
- **In the event of a tie...matching scorecards beginning at the #1 handicap hole and proceeding in order until there is a winner will decide tie scores.**
- The Tournament Chairperson and Townsend's Golf Pro will decide all issues. That ruling is final.
- Townsend Ridge CC course rules and USGA rules govern all instances other than stated here. Please note all out of bounds (O.B.) and hazards on your scorecard.
- Longest Drive (*Drive must be in Fairway*) ~ Hole #2
- Closest to the Pin #15
