"PIETA"

A Pro-Life Artwork by Nikki Bruni

This acrylic on canvas is an original rendition of French artist William Borguereau's "Pieta" and will enhance our sanctuary on Tuesday, April 2nd for two weeks. Within the larger image of Mary and Jesus there are 2,492 tiny faces, representing the lives ended by abortion at Pittsburgh's Planned Parenthood in 2014. The artist chose this image for her pro-life rendering because of the grief-stricken expression on the face of Mary. The purpose of this artwork is two-fold: **First, it is to memorialize each human life by giving them a name. Secondly, this work is meant to help us to recognize the tragedy of abortion, to realize what it has cost us, and to serve as an opportunity to grieve and to repent.**

From the desk of the Administrator

This coming week, my series on the Triduum continues. Two sessions of **Understanding Friday of the Passion of the Lord** will be held. The first is on Monday, 1 April, from 7-9 PM at HSP in the cafeteria in the school building. The same session will be held again on Tuesday, 2 April from 1-3 PM at ASP in the Activities Building. A handicapped entrance can be found on the Wilson Street side of the building. You are welcome to come to either the afternoon or evening sessions, or if you're really crazy, BOTH! All you need to bring is yourself and perhaps some paper if you want to take some notes to remember it all. Those who have attended have been appreciative. There is no pre-registration. Come and learn something about these important days in our Catholic lives.

This coming Thursday, 4 April, the Office of the Tribunal will be holding a free workshop on Annulments. It will take place from 7-8 PM at ASP in the Activities Building. A handicapped entrance can be found on the Wilson Street side of the building. While pre-registration is not required, it's helpful for the Tribunal office to know. Call them at 412-456-3033.

There's also a lot of confession times this week in preparation for Easter. Our own **daytime** "The Light is On for You" will take place at SBP tomorrow from 1-4 PM. Three Priests will be available. Also, on Tuesday evening from 6-7 at SBP as well as Saturday afternoon from 12:30-1:30 at ASP two Priests will be available for confessions. The diocesan-wide "The Light is On for You" confessions are next Wednesday, 10 April from 6-9 PM. Due to that, there will be no evening Mass at ASP or Novena at SBP. Come and be freed of your sin in preparation for Easter.

One of the great resources of our grouping is the Adoration Chapel at SBP. It is open from 8 AM to 10 PM Monday - Friday. More adorers and substitutes are needed. If you are willing to spend an hour with our Lord or act as a substitute when others are unable to attend their hour, you can sign up at <https://adorationpro.org/bonaventure>. You can also call the parish office - 412-486-2606 - and leave your name and contact information. Liturgical Law requires at least two adorers at all times. It would be wonderful to have three, non-related individuals at each hour, just to make sure there is always coverage.

Ministry

This Sunday is a Sunday for rejoicing! The Fourth Sunday of Lent is known as *Laetare* Sunday, which means "Rejoice" in Latin and comes from the Entrance Antiphon which begins with "Rejoice, Jerusalem". The color of the day is rose instead of the typical violet and some of the Lenten liturgical disciplines are lifted, such as the prohibition on instrumental music that is not for the purpose of supporting the singing. The Gospel reading for this Sunday gives us reason to rejoice as well as we hear the parable of the prodigal son. Most of us are familiar with this story of a man who had two sons, an older son who was obedient and a younger son who ran away with his share of his inheritance and squandered it. He decided to repent and return home and the father ran to meet him with great joy that his son had returned. The father had a great celebration for the return of his son, which angered the older son who had been obedient. The father, however, was insistent that the younger son's return was a thing to be celebrated because he was lost and was now found. The same goes for us when we choose to turn back to the Lord. No matter how we may have rejected the Lord and his love in our lives, he will always take us back when we repent and seek forgiveness. God will always rejoice whenever one of his children come back to him, and that is a reason for us to rejoice as well!
