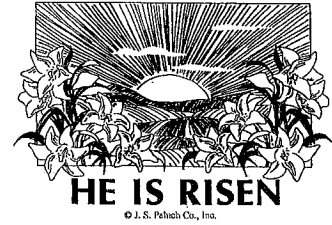

Lector Assignments for Holy Week 2019

- ❖ All Lectors and Narrators of Passion please let the celebrant know you have arrived at the church.
- ❖ If you are a Narrator of Passion or Voice of Passion (Lector) on either Palm Sunday or Good Friday, borrow from the church pew a copy of the missal. You will need the missal to prepare your reading at home. You may mark (highlight) your passages however you wish. Be sure you have the correct reading:
 Palm Sunday Passion narrative is from Luke and begins on page 131
 Good Friday Passion narrative is from Gospel of John on page 144
- You will need to use your missal at the time of your reading as the various parts are not marked in the lectionary.
- ❖ All Lectors will use the Lectionary. If you are lecturing on Palm Sunday or Good Friday, use the Lectionary for your first two readings. Then during the Gospel acclamation, the Lector will move to the cantor microphone on the other side of the Sanctuary to read the "Voice" part of the Passion. The Narrator will go to the usual lectern and begin with "The Passion of our Lord...."
- ❖ If you are the "Voice" of the Passion, bring your marked (highlighted) copy of the missal to the lectern before Mass, then carry it to the cantor microphone. Adjust the microphone height during the Gospel acclamation, if necessary.
- ❖ There will be very little light in the church during the Easter Vigil Old Testament readings.
- ❖ If for any reason you are unable to read at your assigned time, please call Steve Sforzini at 887-9537.
