**VARSITY TEAMS – 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grades**

**Boys:**

Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - “A & B” level players

White Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - “B” level players

Black Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - “C” level players
- No Travel or AAU players permitted on Black rosters

Blue Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys only in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade

**Girls:**

Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of Girls in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - “A & B” level players

White Division:

- Team roster comprised of Girls in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - “B” level players

**JV TEAMS – 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grades**

**Boys:**

Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade - “A & B” level players

White Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade - “B” level players

Black Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade - “C” level players
- No travel or AAU players permitted on Black rosters

Blue Division:

- Team roster comprised of Boys in only in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade

## **Girls:**

### Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of Girls in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade - “A & B” level players

### White Division:

- Team roster comprised of Girls in 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grade - “B” level players

## **PEE WEE TEAMS – 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grades**

## **Boys:**

### Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of all 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys

### White Division:

- Team roster comprised of 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys

### Blue Division:

- Team roster comprised of all 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Boys

## **Girls:**

### Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Girls

### White Division:

- Team roster comprised of all 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Girls

## **ROOKIE TEAMS – 2nd Grade**

### Red Division

- Team roster comprised of 2nd Grade Boys

### White Division

- Team roster comprised of 2nd Grade Girls

## **HIGH SCHOOL TEAMS – 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Grades**

## **Boys:**

### Red Division:

- Team roster comprised of 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys

### White Division:

- Team roster comprised of 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys

## NOTES:

- There are NO CO-ED Divisions in any Archdiocese of Newark Office of Youth & Young Adult Ministry Sports Leagues, including basketball. To further clarify this that means no boys can play on a girls team, and no girls can play on a boys team.
- For teams that have rosters of mixed grades (3/4, 5/6, 7/8) you must play in either the Red, White or Black Division: for example a roster with eleven (11) 7<sup>th</sup> Graders and just one (1) 8<sup>th</sup> grader can not play in the Blue division.
- Rosters of mixed grades that contain “A” caliber players are strongly encouraged to play in the Red Division. This also applies to teams of only lower grade players with “A” caliber players: i.e. an all 7<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> grade roster of “A” caliber players are encouraged to play in the Red Division, or at the very least the White Division.
- Teams with Town Travel team players or AAU players should be placed in the Red or White Divisions. No Town Travel or AAU team players should be on a Black Division Team roster.
- Some Parishes/Schools may elect to add first (1<sup>st</sup>) graders to the rookie team to fill roster spots
