Presents a spirituality of the cantor based on the paschal mystery of Christ as the core of the liturgy and of the cantor's ministry.

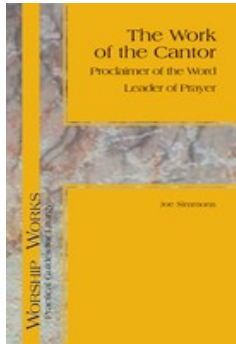
