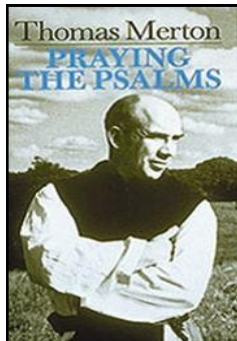

Demonstrates through eight pairs of psalms and parables how the language and working of metaphor impacts our understanding, not only of these texts, but also of ourselves.

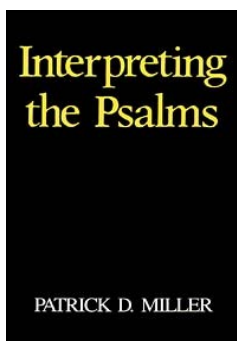

Using representative psalms, Merton shows why the Church considers the psalms the best way to praise God.

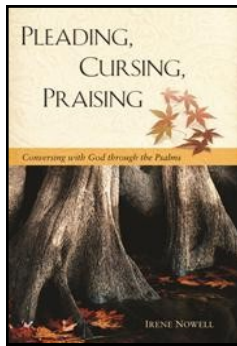

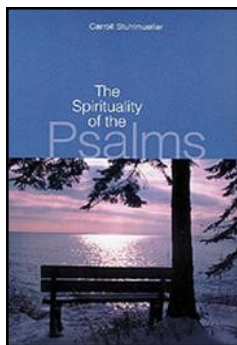
