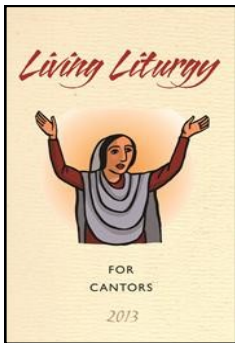

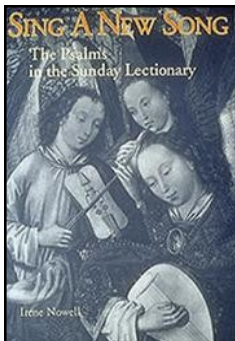


**Living Liturgy for Cantors** by Kathleen Harmon, SNDdeN and Joyce Zimmerman, C.P.P.S., et al. (annual).

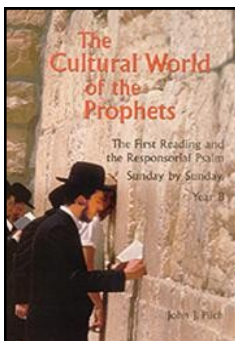


**Sing a New Song: The Psalms in the Sunday Lectionary** by Irene Nowell, OSB (1993).
