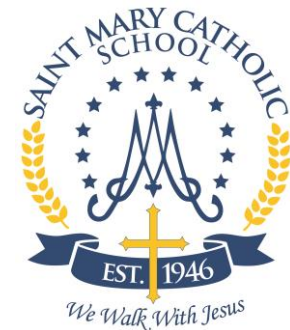

Grant and Scholarship Information

Saint Mary Catholic School is committed to making a Catholic education affordable. There are numerous grant and scholarship possibilities. It is our hope that these tuition assistance options will enable any parent to choose a Catholic education for their child(ren).

Important information and steps to take when applying for a GRANT:

- *Read the requirements for eligibility before applying for grants.
- * Include the required documents.
- * Be aware of deadlines.
- * Apply first to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment Online when applicable.
- * Apply for all grants that you are eligible to receive.

FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment

In order to receive financial assistance, you must submit your financial information to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment which will determine if there is a need based on the information you provide (not necessary for the Step Up For Students Scholarship, AAA, Gardiner, McKay.) Applications must be submitted online at: www.factstuitionaid.com

Current tax information is required to apply for financial assistance. After completing the online application, you will need to mail or fax the supporting documentation.

These two programs and In-House Grants require application to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment:

Kremer Grant

Apply online @ www.factstuitionaid.com by **April 15, 2019**. Income must not exceed the Federal Food Program Maximum Family Income for reduced priced meals.

Students need an IEP written in accordance with the rules of the State Board of Education or with the rules of another state OR the diagnosis of a Florida physician or psychologist or a physician who holds an active license issued by another state or territory of the United States, the District of Columbia or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.
