Dear Parents:

Just this past weekend I had the opportunity to attend Mass during which your children participated in the liturgy by eloquently reading from Sacred Scripture, presenting the Gifts at the Offertory and being present in uniform with their families. One can't help but be impressed with the quality of our Holy Family students as they stand before hundreds and read from The Old Testament and the Letters of the New Testament; this is not easy to do.

It is also not easy to afford a Catholic education today. As we open our celebration of Catholic Schools Week, I want to thank you for choosing Holy Family School for your children. Fr. Donnelly, O.S.A., the Celebrant of the Mass, remarked when greeting our students and their families that a Catholic education in the elementary grades was free in his day. He also noted how blessed we were to have many religious Sisters serve as our faculty.

It is now time to prepare for the next school year, and to that end, we are opening registration for the 2019-2020 school year to our current families.

Please know that we work diligently to ensure that tuition increases are kept to a minimum. We take seriously our responsibility to be good stewards of the school's finances. After careful consideration the Holy Family School Board of Limited Jurisdiction approved the recommendation of its Finance Committee increasing tuition by \$125.00 for Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and 1st through 8th Grades. The CARES fees will remain the same.

We understand that a rise in the cost of tuition may be a burden to some families. At Holy Family School, we never want money to be the barrier between our students and a Catholic education. We highly recommend that families apply for financial aid through [FACTS](#).

Please don't assume you don't qualify. A family with one child and an income of \$100,608 qualifies to receive tuition assistance. A family with two children qualifies for tuition assistance with a household income of \$116,216; three Children \$131,824; four children \$147,432.

The tuition and fee rate schedule for 2019-2020 can be found on our website or by clicking [here](#). These rates do not reflect the true/actual cost of education. Our parishes and the financial support of the Annual Fund also contribute to the financial well-being of our school.

We ask that all families please respond as soon as possible so that we may accurately predict enrollment for next year and effectively plan for staffing and programming needs. We are asking that all current families re-register by Friday, February 22nd. There is a non-refundable re-registration fee of \$250.00 for the family. Please note your registration is not complete until payment is received.
