Notes from the Teacher

Thank you to all of you who were able to support our canned food drive! It is wonderful to see your care for those less fortunate in our community.

This week is the first week of the second trimester. Each month, moving forward, I will ask students to read a book at home (as part of their nightly reading.) At the beginning of each month, I will send home a page for your child to fill out about their book. This page will be due at the end of the month, and we will use it to create a book report at school. Today your child has his or her first book form. It asks for the title of the book your child is reading, the author and the name of the MAIN character. On the back I would like your child to write 2-3 sentences to summarize the beginning, the middle, and the end of the book. Summarizing is a skill we will be practicing throughout December.
