Upcoming Holy Week/ Triduum/Easter Events:

*This Sunday, April 14th, is **Palm Sunday**. Palms will be blessed, we will process into the church as a community and this marks the beginning of Holy Week, the last week of Lent. Palm Sunday commemorates the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem when people placed palm branches on his path.

*Thursday, April 18th is **Holy Thursday**. This day celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and institution of the sacrament of the priesthood. St. Philip's students and staff share a seder meal during the day. Holy Thursday Mass is celebrated at 7:00 pm that evening. Holy Thursday is one of the most beautiful Masses of the year.

*Friday, April 19th is **Good Friday**. This is the only day of the entire year there is not a Mass celebrated anywhere in the world. It commemorates Christ's Passion, crucifixion and death . Good Friday services will be held at 3:00 & 6:30 pm at St. Philip's. Good Friday is a day of fast for adults, meaning one normal meal and two smaller meals, with no eating between meals.

*Saturday, April 20th is **Holy Saturday**. At 8:30 pm, celebrate the Resurrection of Christ at Easter Vigil Mass.

***Easter Sunday**, April 21st. Masses are at 7:30 am, 9:00 am & 11:00 am. (Mass will not be held on Easter Sunday night.)
