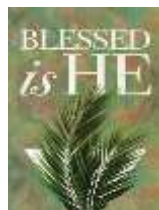

Chrism Mass

The annual Chrism Mass will be held this Tuesday, April 16th, 10:30 AM at St. Columba Cathedral, Youngstown. This Mass celebrates the blessing of Holy Oils of the Catechumens and the Sick, as well as the Chrism. At the close of Mass each pastor will receive Sacred Chrism and the other Holy Oils for use in their parish. The priests also reaffirm their promises made at Ordination. All priests attend this Mass, so there will be no morning Mass here at St. Joseph.
