Child Protection Training (Virtus Training)

If you are planning to work with children in any parish, school, Liturgy of the Word for Children, Youth Ministry, Scouts, Children's Choir, etc. within the Diocese of Youngstown these are the changes that are now in affect:

The Virtus Training is now required. If you previously attended the "Protecting God's Children Training" the new Virtus Program is now required. If you have not been fingerprinted within the last five (5) years you must be re-fingerprinted.

The next Virtus Training at Gaudete Hall will be: **Wednesday, June 19, 2019, 6:30 – 9:00 p.m at St. Joseph School in Gaudete Hall.**

Note: Registration on line is the only way to get credit by the diocese for attendance. When you go on line you will also find the list of other Virtus Training places within the diocese.

The Virtus Training in the Cleveland Diocese does not count for our diocese because the handbook is specific for each diocese.

Fingerprinting: Every five years . (Information will be given at the training.) Initially both FBI and BCI. Cost ranges between \$30 - \$45 per, depending where you go. Have the hardcopy sent to St. Joseph School; 2617 Waterloo Road, Mogadore, 44260.
