AN IMPORTANT UPDATE ON OUR BATHROOM RENOVATION PROJECT!

During last year's Auction, our "Raise the Paddle" effort focused on kicking off fundraising for planned renovations of the school's four bathrooms. We were able to raise \$11,000 to start the process. We are very grateful for the support of Saint Paul Parish, who, as promised, have matched what we raised at our auction and also designated the Parish 2018 End of Year Appeal for the bathroom project, which thus far has raised over \$60,000. We are currently in the planning stages, and as of this week we have accomplished the following: completed initial required State testing, scheduled scoping of existing plumbing, and engaged an architectural design firm. As plans develop, we will continue to share our progress with the school community.

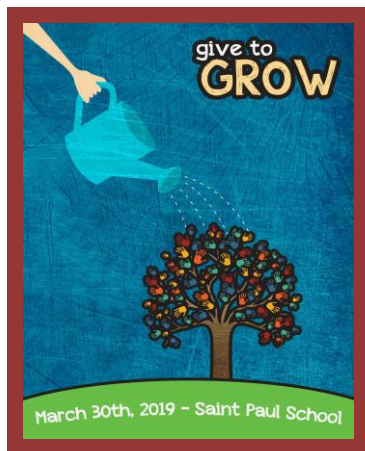
