Dear Parents,

Thank you for registering your child for Sixth and Seventh Grade Edge at the Holy Mothers Collaborative of Saint Mary's and Saint Helen's! If you are new to the program, I hope this letter will help answer any questions you have. If you are returning to the program, this letter should look pretty familiar, however I hope it will serve as a refresher for how Edge works.

Attached to this letter is a schedule of dates for this year's Edge sessions. All Edge sessions (except for our November 4 session) meet at Saint Mary's Parish Center on Sundays from 4:15 to 5:50 p.m. (**Our second Edge session on Sunday, November 4 will begin at 5:30 p.m. at Saint Mary's Parish Center and end at 7:20 p.m. after Life Teen Mass, with pickup at the church**). Edge sessions are held on Sundays to encourage students to attend the Life Teen Mass at 6 p.m. By holding class on Sunday prior to Life Teen Mass, the students are given the opportunity to go straight to Mass after Edge. This Mass is specifically geared toward young people and is intended to be their primary source for catechesis and faith development.

As the most fundamental expression of our Catholic faith, I want to stress how important it is that your child attends Mass each week. **Coming to Edge is not a replacement for going to Mass.** I need your help in making sure your children understand this idea. I would much rather your son or daughter come to Life Teen Mass, get involved in the liturgy every Sunday, and skip Edge, than come to Edge and skip Mass. If you ever have to choose between going to Mass or going to Edge, attending Mass should be the choice every time. **Life Teen Mass is held every Sunday at Saint Mary's at 6 p.m. and is the most vital part of the Edge program.**

I am still in search of a few parents who are willing to give up some of their time to volunteer with the Edge program. Edge sessions include some time in a small discussion group, which will be led by a CORI'd adult or teen. Being a volunteer is very easy. You already know more than you think by virtue of experience, and anything that you do not already know can be easily learned right along with the students. Your main role would consist more of moderating discussion and offering insight, than actually teaching new material. **If you have any interest in helping out, please send me an email at edge@lifeteensmash.com.**

Throughout the year, we will be relying on email and a text message service to alert you if classes need to be cancelled or special announcements need to be made. **We are requesting that all parents (and students with cell phones) sign up for this service by texting "@edgeHMC18" to 81010** and then following the provided instructions. Your cooperation with this request is appreciated.

Edge is designed to be a supplement to the Life Teen program here at Saint Mary's and Saint Helen's. Life Teen is a comprehensive catechetical and faith development program aimed at teenagers. We run a number of events each month, which are listed in the bulletin and posted online. **Middle School students can attend any event that says "Middle School" or "MS,"** and all events are free unless otherwise noted.
