## INFORMATION ABOUT THE CHALICE PROGRAM

Our Assembly By-laws require that we maintain a Chalice Program.

There are two options:

1. to have an individual chalice engraved with the name of a deceased Sir Knight and presented to a priest or church as requested or where needed
2. to have the name of a deceased Sir Knight placed on an annual chalice with the names of those brothers who died during that year.

These options were decided on many years back

when the cost of gold raised the cost of purchasing chalices.

For our new members, I have included a Chalice Placement Request. If you wish to have your name on an Annual Chalice, you don't need to do anything. If you wish to have an individual chalice prepared, then fill out the form and return it to me. The requests are kept in confidence and will be honored.

At this time we do have two chalices on hand, but we will have to continue raising funds to make additional purchases in the future.
