

# A pilgrimage to the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help

The National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help is situated on ten acres of peaceful farmland in northeastern Wisconsin. The site preserves the spot where, in 1859, the Queen of Heaven appeared to a young Belgian immigrant woman named Adele Brise.

As part of the pilgrimage, you will have the opportunity to pray before Our Lady in the Apparition Oratory (which is built on the holy ground where Mary appeared to Adele). In this underground place of prayer, visitors find themselves in a sacred space which inspires an intimate encounter with our Blessed Mother.

The grounds contain a beautiful Church, Chapel, outdoor Rosary Walk, and outdoor Stations of the Cross. You will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and celebrate the Mass with Father Tom Walker.

Our mode of transportation is a 55-passenger (bathroom equipped) charter bus. We will leave St. Michael's Church parking lot at 6:00 A.M. (for the five hour trip). In route, a light breakfast will be served. We will also make a short stop at Kwik Trip to refresh and stretch our legs. The return trip we will include stopping for a meal!

We expect to return home (St. Michael's Catholic Church) by 10:00 P.M.

You are welcome to bring along a lunch, snacks, beverage, etc.

This is a wonderful Pilgrimage; feel free to invite your friends and family!

We are limited to 55 people, so register early, please!
